Dine in the city's various restaurants and paladares, and get swept away in its intoxicating nightlife. Optional evening excursions may include the Tropicana, Buena Vista Social Club, Fabrica de Arte Cubano, and a multitude of other venues throughout the city. Your days' activities begin with a walking tour of Old Havana. Enjoy meeting emerging artists in their studios. Get together with a former ambassador and deputy minister for foreign affairs to discuss Cuba's current political climate and its ever-changing relationship with the United States. Your time in Havana concludes with a special evening at the Ludwig Foundation for the Arts, where the Foundation's president will host a cocktail reception and dinner on the penthouse terrace.

Saturday, August 5 HAVANA

En route to Havana stop in Matanzas for a private concert at the Ermita de Monserrate hilltop chapel, followed by an opportunity to talk with the performers. Continue to Havana and immerse yourself in the vibrant culture of Havana, a city more than 500 years old. After lunch, explore Old Havana on a walking tour and the four main squares: Plaza de la Catedral, Plaza de San Francisco de Asis, Plaza Vieja and, Plaza de Armast. Check-in to your hotel Memories Miramar. Tonight, linger over a cocktail on the terrace of the historic Hotel Nacional (1930). Dinner on own; you might want to try one of Havana's paladares, a privately owned restaurant that oftentimes serves as the owner's home as well. Optional evening excursions

Sunday, August 6 HAVANA B, L

Group 1: Learn about Cuba's current social climate during a lecture by a former ambassador and deputy minister for foreign affairs. Visit some of Cuba's emerging artists' studios. Enjoy lunch at José Fuster's home and studio in the fishing village of Jaimanitas. En route back to Havana visit the home of Ernest Hemingway in the nearby town of Cojimar. The house is much as Papa left it, with original furnishings, personal memorabilia, and works of art on display. Discover Havana after hours, on an optional excursion to some of Hemingway's favorite haunts.

Group 2: Attend a lively dance performance of one of Havana's renowned dance studios. Stroll through Colón Cemetery, whose many monuments commemorate Cuban heroes, statesmen, and novelists. After lunch visit the Museum of Fine Arts.
