#### **BOOK YOUR FLIGHTS**

If you have not already done so, please book your round-trip ticket to Managua, Nicaragua as soon as possible. **Airfare is not included** in the YASC Program Fee.

<u>Arrivals</u>: Please arrive before 2pm on Saturday, March 16th. Last year, Saturday flights to Managua filled up quickly and many volunteers arrived one day early. If your flight arrives on Friday, March 15th, you will be responsible for booking a hotel room at the Best Western in Managua.

<u>Departures</u>: Volunteers who are not planning to attend the extension trip to the Barcelo Montelimar Beach Resort should depart on Saturday, March 23. Those attending the extension trip should depart on Sunday, March 24.

# Elementary Book Wish List for the Nicaragua 2013 Service Trip

In order to help start a comprehensive library for our school in Trohilo, we prepared this booklist. It was compiled from a combination of the reading curriculum in St. Margaret's school in Vina del Mar, Chile and the Newberry and Caldecott award winning books that have been translated into Spanish and are currently available. If you can, please select a book or two and bring them with you to Nicaragua so that we can build a library.

## Where to buy the books

- 51 or about 2/3 of these books on an Amazon.com wish list under "Margaret D Moore". The list will be labeled Nicaragua 2013 when it comes up. Buying from this list will help us ensure that we have offerings across all the grades. However, several of the books have limited availability through Amazon especially at a reasonable price and may no longer be available when you go to make your purchase. The list is set up so that if a book is purchased, it will come off the list and it might still be possible to buy another copy of that book through Amazon if that is your choice.
- Another way to find these books from a US bookseller at a reasonable price is to use the website www.bookfinder.com. It searches many websites around the globe to find the books (new and used). To use this website you need to type in the title and/or the author AND use the drop down menu to select Spanish as the language you are looking for. If they find it, a book title will appear. Click on the book title and they will show you all the people selling the book both new and used. They show you the country from which the books will come so make sure you pick a US source as that is the only way to have a reasonable price and make sure you can get it in time. All of the books listed here could be found at a reasonable price in November 2012 but the lists are constantly evolving and I apologize if you have difficulty finding a book you want.
