Don't forget to bring along a couple books for the library – Spanish or English for elementary school age children.

Speaking of supplies, many of us will be bringing items with us that are needed for our projects since we cannot purchase these in Nicaragua. I have listed below a recent baggage and fee information schedule for international air carriers so you will know what to expect. Usually your bag has to be less than 50lb to qualify for the schedule below before there are overweight charges. You should check with your airline before your flight in case there have been changes.
